

Being a Restraint Reduction Network (RRN) Tutor

Roles and responsibilities

Your role as a tutor means you could be supporting learners with a range of different roles through their journey of completing the certificate or diploma, including:

- support staff
- service managers
- people with professional qualifications, such as nurses, psychologists, or others

We want to help you to make this journey as rewarding as possible for learners, and for tutors.

In your tutor role you will be responsible for organising tutorials and providing a limited amount of 1:1 support to learners to help them understand course concepts and achieve all the learning outcomes. Tutorial guidance and notes will be provided.

You will need to become familiar with the course content which is available on our learning management system.

You will also be responsible for marking and assessing the learners' work and providing feedback in a timely way. There are tutor marked assignments at certificate and diploma level. You will need to assess any resubmitted work you refer that does not meet the standard and help the student understand areas where they may need to do additional work to resubmit to achieve a pass.

These are vocational BTEC qualifications delivered within an adult learning context. Most learners are also working or have other responsibilities, so they are undertaking the qualifications on a part time basis. Many learners may not have studied at this level or in this way before and may need support with some reasonable adjustments. You will need to understand each learner's situation and support them appropriately.

You will need to attend bi-monthly tutor meetings and will have the support of lead tutors and a buddy group.

Payment

Payment is made per group of learners.

£1,200 per certificate group of six learners.

£3,000 per diploma group of six learners.
