What is it?

Surveillance is when staff watch and/or listen to people, places, and property. This is a restrictive practice.

Why is it used?

Lawful surveillance can help check that people, places and property are safe and cared for.





How should it be used?

Surveillance must be used for a specific purpose. All other alternatives which don't breach a person's rights must have been tried.
